Tais (pronounced “tai-sh”) is a type of traditional fabric usually woven by East Timorese women with a backstrap loom, as a form of traditional activity and source of income.

As the finale of their final-year project, Liang Kaixin and Neo Xiaobin from the Wee Kim Wee School of Communication and Information, Nanyang Technological University, explores different aspects of *tais* and takes a look at how the traditional handicraft that has played such a significant cultural and socio-economic role in Timor-Leste has evolved through the years.
